

SCOTLAND 2019 HIGHLANDS AND ISLANDS PHOTOGRAPHIC WORKSHOP 23rd June – 8th July

This amazing and very affordable photographic workshop covering some of the best parts of the highlands, and including five Islands of the Inner and Outer Hebrides is one of amazing beauty, rugged outdoor settings and superb scenery. Having photographed these locations on numerous occasions I can assure everyone the best possible opportunities for fine imagery, no matter what the weather. Photographing Scotland can be a challenge at times, but you will come away with many awesome images.

This tour is 15 nights and 17 days duration. It includes your seat on a very comfortable 9 seat people mover allowing space for all your camera gear and luggage. (We have two mini vans with a second driver) Accommodation; is chosen primarily for central locations, but are all of very good standard, and will always have private facilities. You have the choice of booking a room based on twin share or single supplement. All cooked breakfasts and delicious full dinners are inclusive on this tour for the duration. (Depending on where we are, on any given day, we make time for everyone to purchase a light lunch or snack if they wish, from past experience many find a snack sufficient after a big hearty breakfast)

Your tour includes Ferries from Mull to Skye, Skye to Harris and Harris to Skye. A full day excursion by boat to Staffa Island is also included.

Full tuition and expert guidance throughout the trip. There will be time made during some evenings for critiques of your work and Light-room and Photoshop instruction.

DAY 1 23rd June

Meet up in Edinburgh at our overnight hotel near the Edinburgh International Airport.
(June 23rd overnight stay Edinburgh)

DAY 2 24th June

Edinburgh - Dunkeld – Aberfeldy – Queen Elizabeth lookout – Travel through the Tay forest and along Loch Tummel to Tummel Bridge – Loch Rannmoch and the highland mountains – Through to Braes of Foss – travel along Loch Tay and into the village of Killin.
(June 24th overnight stay Killin)

DAY 3 25th June

Killin is a village situated at the western head of Loch Tay in Stirling, Scotland. The west end of the village is magnificently sited around the scenic Falls of Dochart off the main street. - We then drive following the river Dochart to Crianlarich, then through to Oban passing Kilchurn Castle. – The Ferry at Oban takes us to the Isle of Mull.
(June 25th 26th Two nights stay Isle of Mull)

DAY 5 - 6 26th and 27th June

The lovely charming Isle of Mull – Isle of Staffa boat trip– Puffins – wildlife, seals, Fingals Cave – Tobermory – Catch ferry to the Isle of Skye.

DAY 7 – 10 28th June 29th June 30th June and 1st July

Isle of Skye. Four days of magnificent scenery and coastlines. We make time for the Quiraing, Kilt rock, The old man of Storr, Neist point and Lighthouse, Fairy Glen, Fairy rock pools, Sligachan historic bridge, Black Cuillin views, waterfalls and other wonderful scenes. Skye is totally magnificent and we have time to capture its incredible beauty.
(June 27th 28th 29th 30th and July 1st Five nights stay Isle of Skye)

DAY 11 2nd July

Travelling up through the Isle of Skye – Ferry to the Outer Hebrides – Island of Harris and Lewis with stops on the way.

DAY 12 - 13 3rd and 4th July

Isles of Lewis and Harris. An amazing, and ruggedly, beautiful location. We visit superb coastlines and beaches, with time for a visit to the Callanish standing stones and Carloway Broch. Also, the isle of Scalpay, and the Lighthouse and Tiumpan head.
(July 2nd July 3rd July 4th Three nights stay on Isle of Lewis)

Day 14 -15-16 5th July and 6th July

Leaving the Isle of Harris by ferry we head once more to the – Isle of Skye – A drive through Skye to Kyleakin with stops along the way. Journey from Kyleakin – Visit the alluring and beautiful coastal village of Plockton and surroundings. As Time permits we visit Elgol and the rugged coastline on the southern tip of Skye.
(July 5th and 6th 2 night stay Isle of Skye)

DAY 16 7th July

Drive to Glencoe – A full day in the magnificent Highlands – Photograph Etive Mor, waterfalls, mountain scenery - Drive down to the Bridge of Orchy with stops on the way.
(July 7th Overnight stay in the Bridge of Orchy)

DAY 17 8th July

Bridge of Orchy through to the village of – Crianlarach – onwards to the shores of Loch Lomond, time permitting we can savour various locations on the shores of this beautiful lake - Drive through to Edinburgh Airport, where our tour finishes.
